- Paid work training services offered to students 14 years and older only.

Transition Partnership Program

Offered as a service collaborative with the **California Department of Rehabilitation**, opportunities include: interest assessment, intensive workforce preparation training, concurrent enrollment in local occupational training support, immersive exploration in areas of expressed career interest, career counseling, transition planning, and paid work training.

- **Program Referral** required.

- Student must be enrolled in special education or have a documented disability.

- Applicant subject to Department of Rehabilitation eligibility requirements.

- Applicants must be within two years of exit from high school, or at least 16 years of age.
